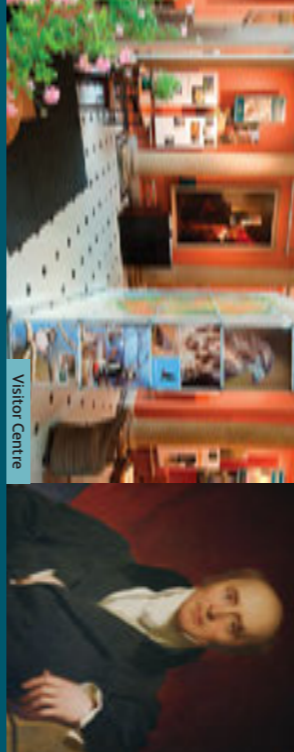

Welcome to Howick Hall Gardens

The gardens at Howick are deliberately aimed at garden lovers with the extensive grounds offering a wide variety of plants throughout the year.

In the spring and early summer the Woodland Garden is particularly lovely with rhododendrons, camellias and magnolias. In April there are spectacular drifts of daffodils throughout the grounds and in May the tulips appear in the wild flower meadows.

The formal gardens are in front of the house and come into their own from June onwards. A Bog Garden has been planted with herbaceous material grown from seed collected in the wild, which will be of particular interest to dedicated plantmen.



What is an Arboretum?

An Arboretum is a collection of trees and shrubs.

The Arboretum here at Howick covers about 65 acres with over 12,000 trees and shrubs grown from seed collected on expeditions to many parts of the world, since 1985.

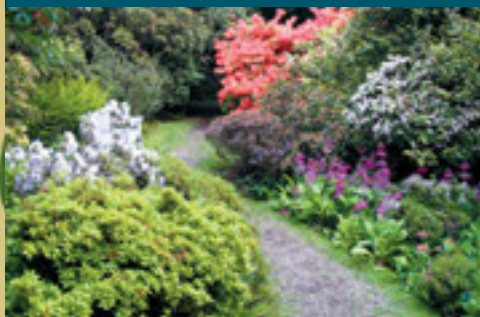




IMPORTANT VISITOR INFORMATION
